Starting July 30, All Saints will be running a new, 5-week course exploring some of the most common challenges to trusting Jesus.

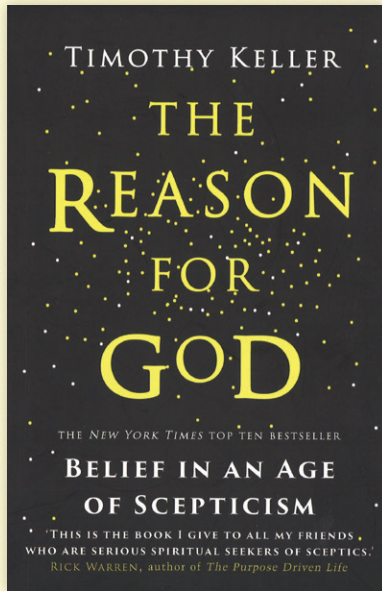
Based on a best selling book — *The Reason for God* — this course is ideal for people who doubt... but with an open mind.

Here's a snapshot of what we'll cover...



1. The Bible...seriously?

2. One way to God...that's so intolerant!

Religion causes so much conflict. Blind faith in religious teaching has no place in our modern, tolerant community.

3. Christianity is oppressive

People should be free to live however they like. The bible's old-world morality oppresses women and sidelines anyone who thinks differently.

4. Human suffering and evil...

If god exists, he/she/it is EITHER all-powerful but won't prevent evil OR god is unable to prevent evil. Both are pathetic.

5. The Christian church has no credibility
